

Technology Enhanced Learning Discovery Workshop

What is it?

It is a two hour workshop developed by Mark Bailye and Caroline Steel to explore institutional *successes and challenges* in relation to technology enhanced learning. The workshop uses a set of cards based on eight themes to stimulate conversations and trigger questions that uncover exemplary practices, challenge areas and institutional insights. A short institutional report is then generated with recommendations.
